

Public Notice

Josephine County will be taking applications for project eligible for Statewide Transportation Improvement Fund (STIF) program. Specifically, the purpose of the STIF funds are to finance investments and improvements in public. The funds are primarily for improvements and expansion of public transit services.

Additional eligible projects are the planning, operations and administration of STIF funded public transportation projects, including, but not limited to:

- Creating new systems and services with origins, destination or stops in Josephine County
- Maintaining existing services and systems
- Developing local transit plans
- Local match for state and federal public transit projects

An estimated \$1,941,000 is available through June 2021.
