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## MOBILE UNIT REQUIREMENTS OUTLINE

Congratulations on your decision to consider a new business venture! As you explore this opportunity, the Josephine County Environmental Health Department is ready to assist you through the licensing and regulatory process.

This packet contains information regarding the legal requirements of operating your business. It is very important that you familiarize yourself with this information before you begin development of your establishment. ### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Whenever you start a new food service operation, there is a 2-part “plan review” process you must go through. The first step “submittal” must be completed before construction begins. The second step “Pre-Operational Inspection” must be completed before you can open.

#### SUBMITTAL:

A set of quality plans (drawn to scale) must be received by our department. Refer to the attached “Mobile Unit Plan Review” for expected content. The plan fee for new construction or a major remodel is \$189.00. The plan review fee is not refundable.

The submittal process varies throughout the county, as follows:

Upon receipt of the “plan review fee” the Plans Examiner will review the plans for such items as type of menu, sinks, food equipment, and types of wall/floor coverings. A letter stating “plan approved” or a letter outlining corrections needed will be sent after the plans are reviewed. If construction has begun before the plan review is approved, the food service operations owner may be charged a penalty fee.

#### PRE-OPERATIONAL INSPECTION:

Once the construction has been finished or you have a completed unit then you will need to schedule a pre-operational inspection. Contact the Plans Examiner responsible for reviews in your area at least one week before you wish to open. There is a penalty for beginning to operate without approval.
