SUMMARY

The Work Crew Coordinator supervises a crew of sentenced offenders, either released from the County jail or assigned to the work crew by the community services staff. Work crews consist of adult and juvenile offenders and provide uncompensated labor to the community. The coordinator transports adult and juvenile offenders to the assigned job sites and instructs and oversees their work daily. Work typically includes landscape maintenance, construction, equipment moving, and other physical labor.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

(Illustrative Only. Any single position in the classification will not necessarily involve all the listed duties below and other positions will involve duties which are not listed. These duties represent the essential functions needed of persons in this classification.)

1. Assess work project requests. Estimate equipment, materials and time required to complete individual projects. Determine appropriate work projects for crew workers considering physical limitations and available resources.
2. Instruct workers in the proper work procedures and use of tools and equipment. Enforce safety procedures and work crew program rules.
3. Make recommendations regarding worker discipline and performance evaluations.
4. Transport workers, supplies, and equipment to and from work sites.
5. Assist injured workers in obtaining medical attention.
6. Perform and/or demonstrate grounds-keeping, landscaping, construction, maintenance, and other functions as necessary to crew members.
7. Perform and/or supervise general maintenance on all tools and equipment.
8. Operate equipment (landscaping, carpenter, painting, and power tools).
9. Obtain breath and urinalysis samples from offenders for detection of alcohol or illicit drug use.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES

This job has no supervisory responsibilities. However, incumbent is responsible for coordinating and supervising the work of crew members.

QUALIFICATIONS

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

Associate degree (A.A.) or equivalent from two-year college or technical school; or two to three years related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience. Requires general knowledge of the methods, practices, tools and materials used in construction and landscape maintenance techniques, knowledge of applicable safety hazards and practices. Ability to operate a variety of tools and shop equipment.

JOB IMPACT

Consequences of error could include exposure to litigation and public embarrassment due to such incidents as improper maintenance of custodial units or inappropriate referrals. Error may also result in injury to self or others.

JOB CONTACTS

The position requires working with individuals referred to the Community Services / Work Crew Program, the court system, law enforcement, adult and juvenile parole and probation officers, contracting agencies, social service agencies and community services agencies around the state or country.

LANGUAGE SKILLS

Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating/maintenance instructions and procedure manuals. Ability to write routine reports and correspondence. Ability to speak effectively before groups of customers or employees of organization; understand and carry out oral and written directions; establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with co-workers and the general public; establish standards of performance; and motivate workers.

MATHEMATICAL SKILLS

Ability to add, subtract, multiply, and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, common fractions, and decimals. Ability to compute rate, ratio, and percent in practical situations and to create and interpret graphs and charts.

REASONING ABILITIES

Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral, or diagram form. Ability to deal with problems involving several concrete variables in standardized situations. Ability to plan, schedule and supervise work crew assignments; provide effective leadership and supervision of crew members; maintain discipline of crew members; perform duties under tight deadlines and/or in emergency situations; use independent judgment in performing routine and non-routine tasks.

OTHER SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Ability to operate various tools and equipment; exercise good judgment and common sense; comprehend, interpret and apply rules pertaining to community service and work crews.

CERTIFICATES, LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS

Possession of or ability to obtain valid Oregon Driver's License; possess safe driving record; possession of or ability to obtain First Aid/CPR Certification.

BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION

Those employed in this position may be subject to pre-employment drug testing and a background investigation, including but not limited to criminal background investigation. Conviction of a crime will not necessarily disqualify an individual for this classification.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly exposed to outside weather conditions. The employee is frequently exposed to moving mechanical parts. The employee is occasionally exposed to high, precarious places; fumes or airborne particles; extreme heat; and vibration. The noise

level in the work environment is usually moderate to loud as crew members will be required to use equipment such as lawn mowers and weed removal equipment. Litter patrol crew would encounter traffic noise.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
